Litigation that arises from an individual or corporate fidicuary's role as a trustee, beneficiary or other interested party in the administration, construction or reformation of a trust instrument, including:

- Breach of trustee's duties
- Disputes among class of beneficiaries
- Disputes over discretionary distributions
- Selection of successor trustee
- Trust reformation and trust termination actions
- Disputes involving charitable trusts and foundations

Probate Litigation

Will contest actions and other causes of action that arise from an individual or corporate fiduciary's role as a personal representative, beneficiary or other interested party in the administration of a decedent's estate, including:

- Ambiguities that arise in drafting and/or interpreting the will
- Disputes over the appointment of a personal representative
- ▷ Fiduciary fee disputes
- Spousal elective share disputes
- ▷ Accounting disputes

When will contest litigation usually arises:

- \triangleright Lack of capacity
- \triangleright Undue influence
- Improper execution or drafting of document

Family Succession Planning Litigation

Litigation involving personal and business transitions within a family, usually occurring as a family member ages. Disputes may involve the decisions made by aging family member or decisions made on behalf of a family member, including:

- Contested guardianships
- ▷ Business succession plan disputes
- ▷ Conservatorship planning and litigation
 - ▷ Special needs planning
 - ▷ Interfamily relations and governance
 - ▷ Lifetime gift transfers
